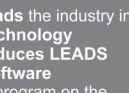

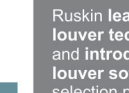

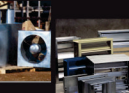

Ruskin was the first manufacturer in the 1990s to receive louver product approval for use in Miami-Dade County



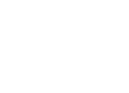
